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# Sherpa Demo Environment

## *Usage and Install Guide*

### Usage

The Sherpa demo site provided by Active Commerce may be used for evaluation, demonstration, and training purposes only. At no time may it be installed in a manner which allows access by anyone other than the Active Commerce partner to which it has been provided, the partner's customers, and the partner's prospective customers.

### Installation Instructions

- Install Sitecore, DMS, SES, and Active Commerce per the instructions found in the *Active Commerce Installation and Developer Quick Start* documentation.
  - a. Install the [Mobile Device Detector](#) module noted in Step #4.
  - b. Skip Step #5, "Modify Web.config," as the Sherpa package comes with a modified Web.config already.
- Under App\_Config\Include, rename DataFolder.config.example to DataFolder.config. Edit the file to specify the correct installation path for your Sitecore data folder.
  - a. e.g. c:\inetpub\wwwroot\Sherpa\data\
- Install the following Active Commerce plugins. **Be sure to utilize the version of the packages appropriate for your Sitecore version.**
  - a. UPS
  - b. USPS
- Install the Active Commerce Sherpa package. **Be sure to utilize the version of the packages appropriate for your Sitecore version.**
  - a. Click "Yes" to override the Web.config.
- Perform a full site Smart Publish.
- From the Control Panel or Sitecore Rocks, rebuild the Link Database on *master* and *web*.
- From the Developer Ribbon or Indexing Manager, rebuild all search indexes.
- Adjust site definition in xActiveCommerce.Sites.config and IIS bindings as needed to expose the Sherpa site on the desired host name.
- To demonstrate VIP pricing, create an extranet\SherpaVIP role, and assign a customer account to the role.
- To enable order receipts and other emails, configure the Sitecore *MailServer* setting in Web.config or in an include file.
