Notes on Upgrading from Active Commerce 3.2

- If you are upgrading from an earlier version of Active Commerce, reference the Release Notes for Active Commerce 3.2.
- After installing, you must update the database schema. To do this:
 - Go to the following address: <http://<site host>/sitecore/admin/databaseutility.aspx>
 - Click the "Update Schema" button
 - You should see a "Success!" message when completed
- To resolve issues with the Experience Explorer on Sitecore 8, the jQuery script include has been moved to the bottom of the HTML document. If you have inline scripts that are dependent on jQuery, we recommend adjusting them accordingly.
- As with any Active Commerce upgrade, you should utilize WinMerge or another diff tool to analyze any changes in the base skin against any CSS, Javascript, or Sublayouts which you have skinned.
- If upgrading to the September Coveo for Sitecore release, we recommend upgrading Coveo first, and then installing the latest Active Commerce.

Authorize.NET

Site Configuration

- [AC-877] - The "EcommerceSiteSettings" site definition attribute now accepts an absolute item path or GUID, which allows more flexibility in where the business catalog and site settings are in the content tree, or creating site-specific settings for regional/country domains.

Issues Resolved

- [AC-805] - Resolved issue with access to product stock data when extending view model factories
- [AC-808] [AC-875] - Improved error messaging when FedEx plugin isn't properly configured
- [AC-810] - Removed a confusing and unnecessary default tax configuration option
- [AC-813] - Resolved an error message that would appear in the logs on failed credit card payments in Content Delivery environments
- [AC-817] - Resolved an issue where tax rate providers returning null or empty tax rates results in an exception during checkout
- [AC-841] - Improved handling of "insufficient stock" error message popup for large carts
- [AC-854] - Resolved an issue with saving of order history when two new customer accounts are created in the course of the same browser session

- [AC-882] - Mobile rules are now enabled by default on Sherpa demo site install
